Job Description	 Teaching and administrative duties as an Associate Director of the Human Sciences International Undergraduate Degree Program, including admissions. *This position involves teaching approximately four courses per semester, including dissertation-related seminars, as well as supervising undergraduate students. Lectures and seminar classes for one course are given once a week per subject per semester, for a total of 15 weeks). *Some courses will be held at the Toyonaka Campus Serve on committees related to the running of the program Research activities related to the above areas.

Qualifications	The successful candidate will have: 1) Experience of teaching higher education courses in English in the above field. 2) A PhD in political science or a related field 3) Experience in running an educational program at a university or other higher education institution 4) At least five publications in internationally recognized peer reviewed journals or equivalent 5) Ability to work competently and effectively in English to support the running of the Program. 6) Daily communication skills in Japanese
