

## Faculty Position in the Graduate School of Human Sciences, Osaka University

Outline	The School of Human Sciences was established in 1972 covering three academic disciplines: psychology, sociology and education. It was the first school or faculty to carry the name 'human sciences' in the country. In 1976 the Graduate School of Human Sciences was created offering Master level program. Doctoral level program was established in 1978. Today areas of study include behavioral sciences, psychology, sociology, biological and cultural anthropology, education, philosophy, development studies and area studies. Evaluation will be reviewed 1 year before the expiration date of the term, and if one is qualified, the one will continue to be employed as B or A. If it is deemed necessary in the above evaluation, the one will be reappointed (3 years, once only). In the case of the reappointment, the re-examination will be conducted one year before the expiration date of the term, and if it is deemed to be eligible, the employment will continue as B or A.

17. Selection Process	Based on background and achievements, if the candidate is an associate professor equivalent, the one will be selected as A: an associate professor (no fixed term). If the candidate is an associate professor (lecturer) equivalent, and is within about five years of obtaining a Ph.D. (or a person deemed to be equivalent to this), the one will be selected as B: a tenure-track associate professor (lecturer)(five years with a fixed term).
