5. Specialized Field	We are looking for someone with a strong background in political science who is able to also teach statistics for the social sciences and quantitative research methods. The successful candidate will play a key role in the Politics and Global Studies focus of the Program, including dissertation supervision.
6. Job Description	This is a specially appointed position for the Human Sciences International Undergraduate Program, a former Global 30 program. The position involves teaching four courses per semester as well as contributing to the undergraduate dissertation-related seminars. One course equals teaching one class per week for 15 weeks. In addition, the position involves making a major contribution to the running of the program, both administratively and also in terms of student supervision. While this is not a research post, all professors working on this program to date have been research active. The successful candidate should be able to teach the following courses: Introduction to Politics Introduction to Global Studies Quantitative Research Methods Statistics for Social Sciences Political Economy Global Citizenship Globalization Studies It would be helpful if the successful candidate could also teach East Asian Politics. In addition, the successful candidate will offer instruction and research supervision to 3rd year independent study and 4th year dissertation students. Some teaching on Toyonaka Campus.

Qualifications	Successful candidate will have: a) Experience of teaching higher education courses in English in the above field. b) A PhD in political science or related fields c) At least three publications in internationally recognized peer reviewed journals d) Ability to work competently and effectively in English to support the running of the Program. e) Some Japanese communication skills

The contract may be renewed depending on satisfactory work performance for a maximum of ten years from the initial starting date, subject to program budgets.
