Outline	The School of Human Sciences was established in 1972 covering three academic disciplines: psychology, sociology and education. It was the first school or faculty to carry the name 'human sciences' in the country. In 1976 the Graduate School of Human Sciences was created offering Master level program. Doctoral level program was established in 1978. Today areas of study include behavioral sciences, psychology, sociology, biological and cultural anthropology, education, philosophy, development studies, kyosei studies and area studies. We are now inviting applications for an associate professor or a lecturer of Social Inquiries in Education course.
